Quick After-Use Checklist

- Wipe down benches and high-touch surfaces with a mild sauna cleaner (pH ~6–8)
- Open the door to ventilate and let humidity escape
- Run the heater on low for ~20 minutes until interior surfaces are dry

Exterior Care

Iglusauna roof and wall shingles are a natural material that expands and contracts with weather. A UV-tinted factory finish is applied to the exterior to protect the wood. Over time, small uncoated areas can appear—this is normal and does not affect service life.

Touch up: Use the touch-up paint supplied with your sauna as needed.

Interior Care

Interior wood is finished with a water-based sauna wax to resist moisture and heat swings. Wood can darken slightly with use and fine dust from stones; this is normal. Avoid scratching the floor with stones or sharp objects.

Maintenance: If necessary, lightly sand and re-wax to refresh the surface.
